These terms and conditions are set out by MRS Web Solutions for all customers who use our social media channels. Any submission of material by you must abide by our terms and conditions. Our terms and conditions supplement any third party terms and conditions that may apply to you.

1. Moderation

Contributions submitted to our community will be checked by us for compliance with the content standards listed below as soon as is reasonably practicable after publication.

MRS Web Solutions are under no obligation to you or any other person to oversee, monitor or moderate our community or your social media community. We reserve the right to remove or disable access to any contribution which we deem to be in breach of our content standards after it has been published. We expressly exclude our liability for any loss or damage arising from the use of the community by any person in contravention of these rules on our social media or the social media that we assist in marketing for.

2. The Community (those who comment)

When using the community, you acknowledge that:

- a. Views are expressed by an individual and do not necessarily reflect the views of MRS Web Solutions
- b. Any advice that is given is posted as a general view of the person who posts it and not necessarily the view of MRS Web Solutions
- c. Any advice which is given should not necessarily be accepted as true or correct and it is up to you to check the validity of the information given

3. Content Standards

- i. You must not commit any lawful or criminal act or condone any unlawful or criminal act



4. Copyright

By submitting content to the community, you agree to grant MRS a non-exclusive license to use that contribution and to waive your moral rights.
